IN MEMORIAM – TERRY HILL –

WORD has reached me of the passing of Terry Hill at Hobart in Tasmania.
It was received with sadness.

Though I never met Terry, we had several long phone conversations during
the time I was conducting research for the book MASS MURDER (2014) which
addresses the official killing at and near Port Arthur, Tasmania, in April 1996.
(The incident for which criminal officials imprisoned innocent Martin Bryant.)

Unlike so many other people, Terry answered my questions. He gave me not
subjective, but objective answers that all had the ring of truth.

In time, I received a copy of the intimidating letter (6 June 1996) sent to him
by the then lawyer John Avery of Moonah, Tasmania. John Avery, a criminal
who later was imprisoned for misappropriating the money of others.

Unlike so many other people, Terry stood up for the truth and refused to be
intimidated. For his moral stand, officials put him out of business.

The relationship between Avery and the then Director of Public Prosecutions
(believed to be Damian Bugg), as is documented in Avery's letter, is blatant
corruption. The letter is reproduced on page 31 of the above-mentioned book.
